


PAYMENT: Payment may be charged to your account but it is strictly nett and due for payment not later than the 20th of the month following date of despatch.

FREIGHT AND PACKING: Free by normal means to the nearest railway station.

Roses are tolerant to a wide range of conditions, but their preference is for deep firm loam enriched with compost or humus. Once established, they respond to occasional dressings of a fertiliser consisting of 2 parts superphosphate and 1 part of sulphate of potash.



On their 5ft to 6ft stems, these make outstanding specimens either in a lawn, or in the centre of a bed. Weeping standards should be summer pruned; that is, immediately after flowering. Any old, or over mature trailing stems can also be removed. This encourages long growths during summer which flower the following spring. We believe the following are the best of their colour.
