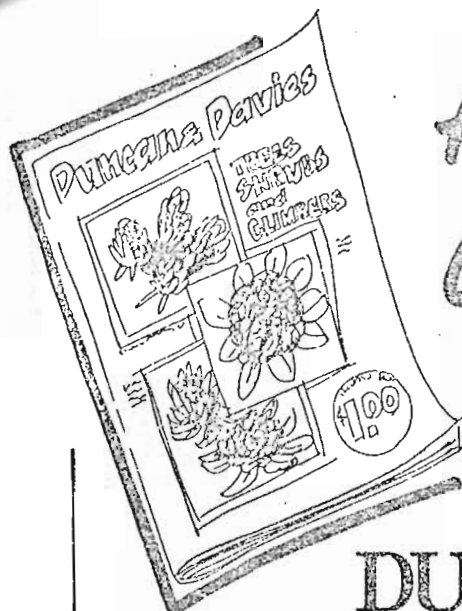

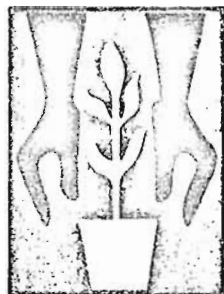

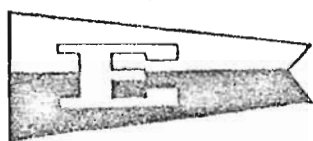

Y115	METRUSIDEROS FULGENS AURATA (Aka) PB 3 15/20 2.00 A lovely climbing form of rata displaying yellow flowers. Suggest planting below a tree fern so that the plant can scramble aloft. Root area does need shade. A rare plant - and we have a very limited supply, so order early.
Y116	KERMADECENSIS SUNNINGHILL (Variegated PB 8 20/30 2.30 Pohutukawa) Bright green leaves, splashed lemon-yellow in the centre.
Y117	K. RADIANT (NEW) - Compact bushy shrub, PB 8 20/30 2.50 shiny dark green leaves with a large area of creamy-yellow in the centre. The older leaves retain this colouring.
Y118	K. RED AND GOLD - Deep green leaves PB 8 20/30 2.10 attractively margined golden-yellow stand out against the deep red of the young branchlets.
Y119	K. JESTER (NEW) - Small deep green leaves PB 8 20/30 2.50 with an irregular yellow splash in the centre, young juvenile branchlets are an attractive deep red in colour.

The variegated Pohutukawas are very suitable for all gardens, even the smaller ones. They grow slowly into small trees, but by careful pruning can be kept into well shaped reasonably large sized shrubs.

These plants are very wind hardy and will even grow fairly well in poor soil conditions.

The flowering display can be just as effective as the species.

We suggest there's a place for one in most gardens not subjected to severe Winter frosts.
