THE magnolia, named for Pierre Magnol (1638-1715), a director of the Botanical Gardens at Montpellier in France, is the name genus and one of the 10 genera of the family Magnoliaceae.

There are some 80 species today; 50 of these are native to Asia found in the great horticultural triangle formed by Japan in the east, the Himalayas to the west and Indonesia to the south.

The remainder come from eastern North America, Central America and the West Indies.

The Magnoliaceae are considered to be among the oldest of our flowering plants. In fossil form they are traced back to prehistoric times with a much broader distribution pattern than today's natural habitat suggests.

With such an ancient lineage it is not surprising that the earliest known references are to the medicinal qualities of magnolias, and that these come from China.

The beauty of its flowers made it a favourite with embroiderers and artists of the East. Yet there are places where it is felled for firewood!

M. virginiana and *M. grandiflora* - distinct form that sets them apart from other flowering trees arrived about 1688.

M. liliflora was introduced to Europe by Thunberg from China in 1782 or shrub from the temperate region of Japan. A retired cavalry officer had a wide range of soil types and succeeded in crossing *M. liliflora* and *denudata* to produce a race of hybrids we call *M. soulangeana*.

In the latter half of the 19th century five species were introduced from Japan and one from the Himalayas, *M. campbelli*.

By the turn of the century the great plant-hunters like Wilson and Forrest were

The first forests of these trees that astonished the early plant-hunters in Asia have almost disappeared, felled for firewood. In Central America many have been felled but there the blooms are sold for home decoration — for this they cut down the whole tree!

Strange that a genus able to live more than a 100 million years cannot survive puny man; and fortunate that all species are so attractive to horticulturists, which ensures that they will not be lost entirely.

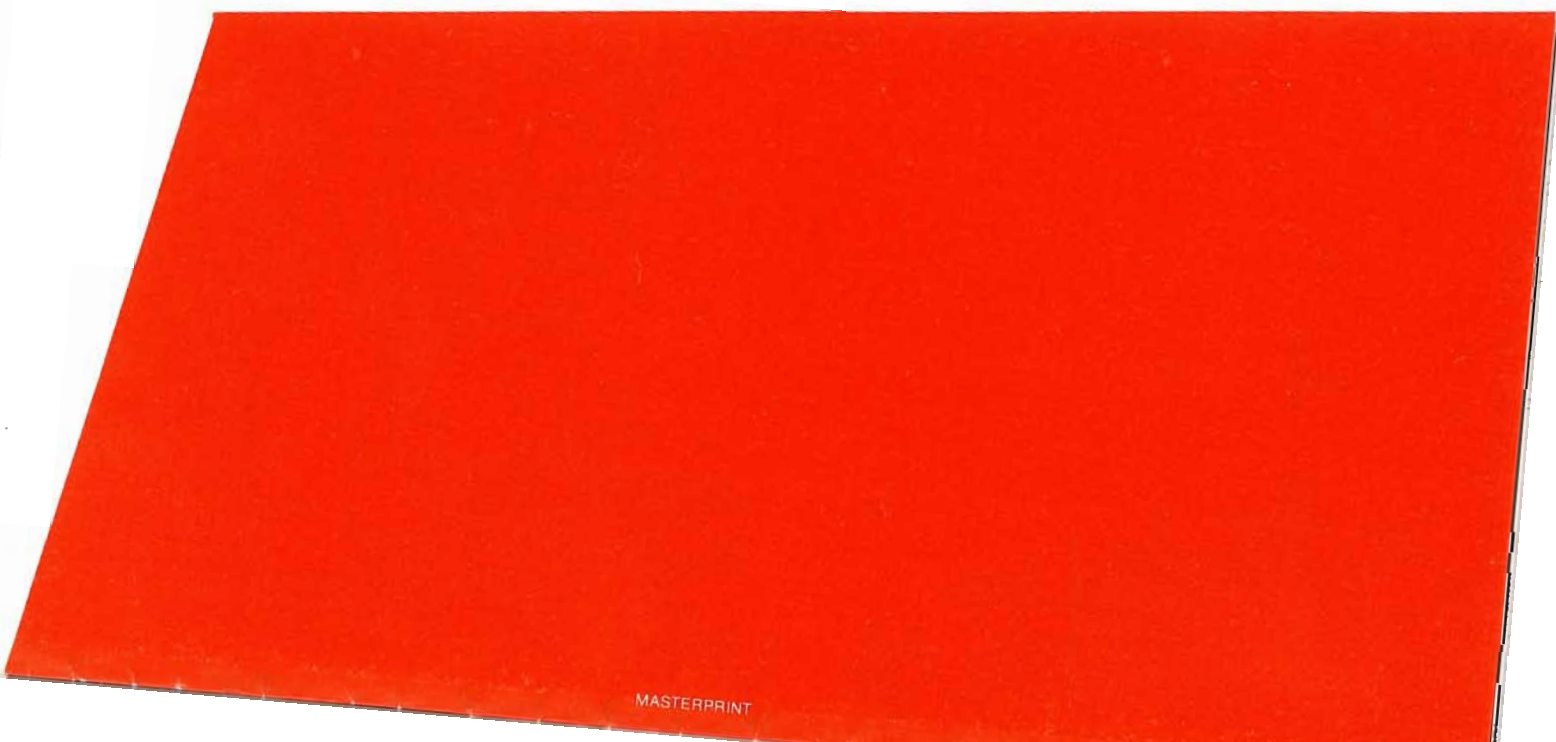

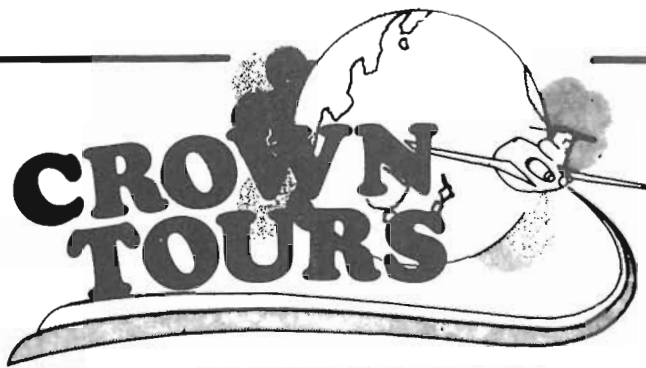
