We ask that these forward orders be returned by the 11 February to enable us to process quantity confirmations by the 28 February. Orders will be taken in date order of receipt in this office.

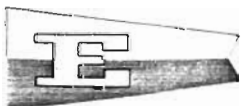

A good garden variety that is a reliable annual producer of large to medium bright yellow fruit early in the season.

PEACH ANABELLE

A Zaiger U.S.A. Standard Peach. A superior peach tree yielding exceptionally high quality white flesh peaches with superb aroma and flavour. Fruit are large and deep rosy red in colour with soft white flesh. Anabelle ripens late December.

PEACH ANITA

A Zaiger U.S.A. Standard Peach. Similar to Anabelle this is another fine gourmet peach from the same breeding programme. Fruit colour is soft rosy red; the fruit medium to large in size with soft white flesh of high aroma and exceptional flavour, ripening in mid December.

Both Peaches Anabelle and Anita fall into the non-commercial category producing extremely high quality white fleshed gourmet fruit that are difficult to ship to market without bruising. Such fruit producing trees belong traditionally to the garden domain where the high quality fruit can be picked and consumed at its optimum condition. Therefore both products become ideal garden centre sales items. Connoisseur trees for discerning gardeners.

PEACH HONEYHALE

A Zaiger U.S.A. SEMI DWARF PEACH - usually attaining a height of about 60% the size of a normal standard Peach tree. Requiring a relatively low winter chilling period this peach should be ideal for New Zealand climatic conditions. Very large, juicy, golden red fruit in high yield crops about mid February. Exceptionally good eating, this fruit has a J.H. Hale quality and size on a small growing tree.

1983 ADVANCE ORDER LIST

We draw your attention to the following points clarifying our 1983 Advance Order List -

- (1) To overcome the problem of late CONFIRMATIONS, these will now be issued in TWO PARTS :

- (a) confirming QUANTITIES only, no later than 28 February 1983.  
(b) confirming final GRADES and PRICES about May/June 1983.

This initial action will allow customers time to source product elsewhere if necessary. Leaving final confirmation of grades closer to the date of lifting and despatch will also ensure greater correspondence between grade and quantity confirmed and product received than was possible previously.

- (2) TRADE TERMS will change from April 1, 1983 to an EX-NURSERY basis, instead of the freight and packing paid to nearest rail station which applies at present. This action is taken with reluctance and has been brought about by recent steep increases in freight costs. In effect, customers closer to our nursery were being asked to increasingly subsidise those further away. Thus from April 1, 1983 product may either -
- (a) be collected from Nursery at customers' expense, or  
(b) be despatched freight forward by rail.

In this instance we require details of your rail ledger code.

If no ledger code is available, we will add the actual rail cost to your account.

- (3) The effect on PRICES of moving to Ex-Nursery terms is expected to lower prices over those ruling in 1982 by around 4%. This figure could possibly be affected by any changes in the present wage and price freeze regulations. However, PRICES CONFIRMED for all forward ordered quantities will be strictly adhered to, subject only to variation in grade.
- (4) COLOURED PICTORIAL LABELS will be supplied on certain lines as indicated throughout the list.
- (5) BUDDED and GRAFTED product is identified throughout the list.
