Duncan & Davies have been working for several years selecting varieties for propagation and developing a superior understock from sources substantially free of known viruses - FKV.

The name 'High Health' was coined by the University of California to describe selected and tested elite propagating material.

Now our work is complete and we are proud to present the Duncan & Davies 1983 rose crop as 'High Health' roses.

'High Health' DOES mean that D & D's 'High Health' roses will grow BETTER --- will grow with more VIGOUR --- with cleaner, brighter, more clear flower COLOUR --- with better flower PETAL TEXTURE --- with larger and cleaner LEAVES that do not have unsightly yellow mottling, veining and marking.

'High Health' does NOT mean that roses will not at some time in their garden life suffer attack from fungal diseases such as Black Spot and mildew, problems which affect all roses and which the knowledgeable gardener and retailer solve with a co-ordinated garden maintenance rose spraying programme.

Duncan & Davies roses will be lifted in late May / early June, weather permitting and processed and despatched to our customers during June.
