In an effort to keep freight and packing costs to a minimum, particularly on bulky field grown evergreen material, D&D Research & Development Department has conducted a major investigation over the past two years into alternative forms of packaging. Some trial shipments were made in 1983 in the form of "net balled" DAPHNES, TELOPEAS AND EMBOTHRIMUMS. As well as affording the desired "supportive" cultural characteristics to the root-balls of these sometimes difficult-to-handle plants, the elasticised netting proved to be a winner in so far as speed of handling and actual freight cost were concerned. A D&D net balled evergreen WEIGHS FROM 30, UP TO 50% LESS than comparable bagging methods: but we felt "eye-appeal" may have left something to be desired, so further work was carried out and we are pleased to advise we've found an answer to that problem also. We have slipped a handsome printed

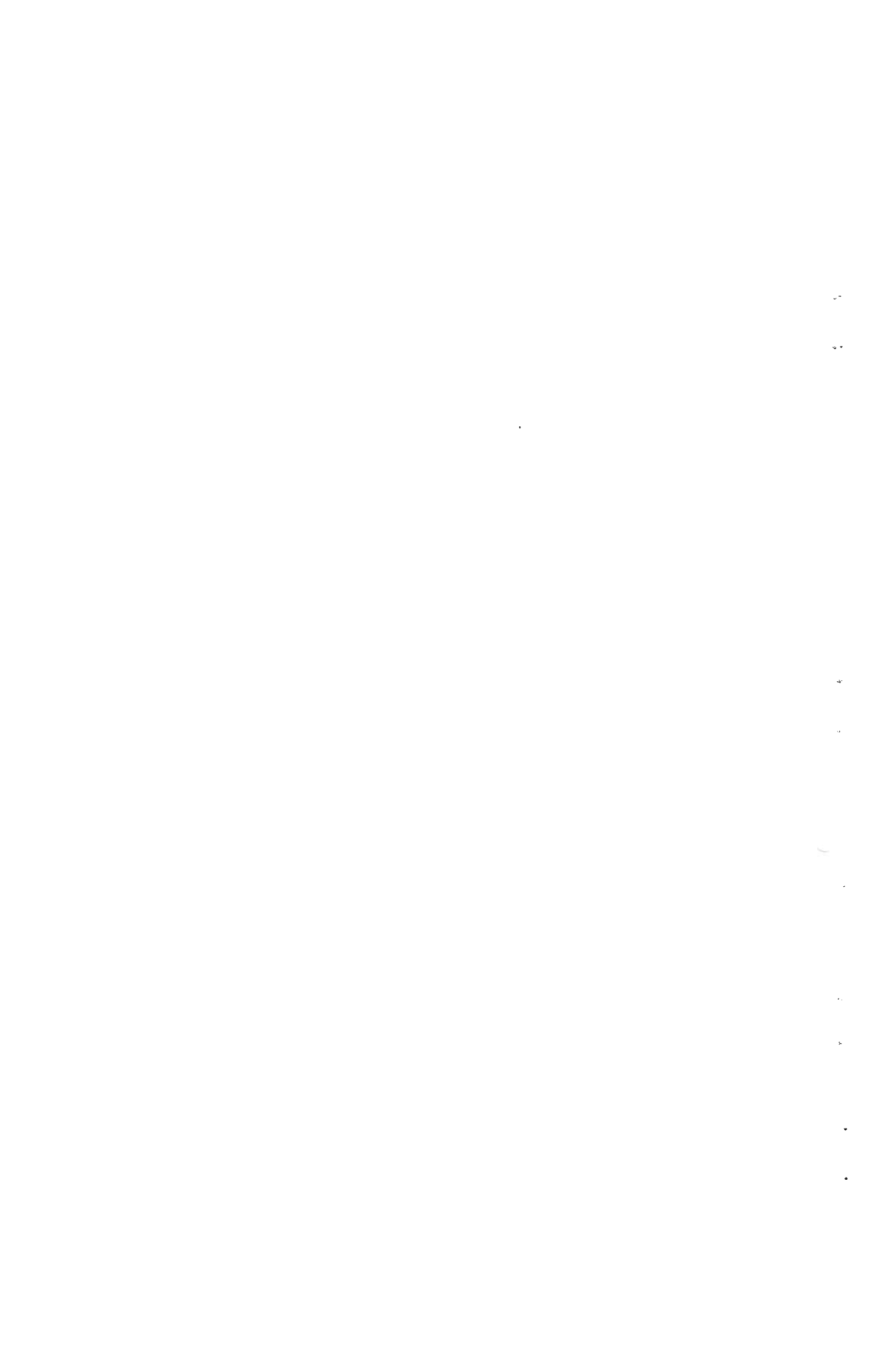

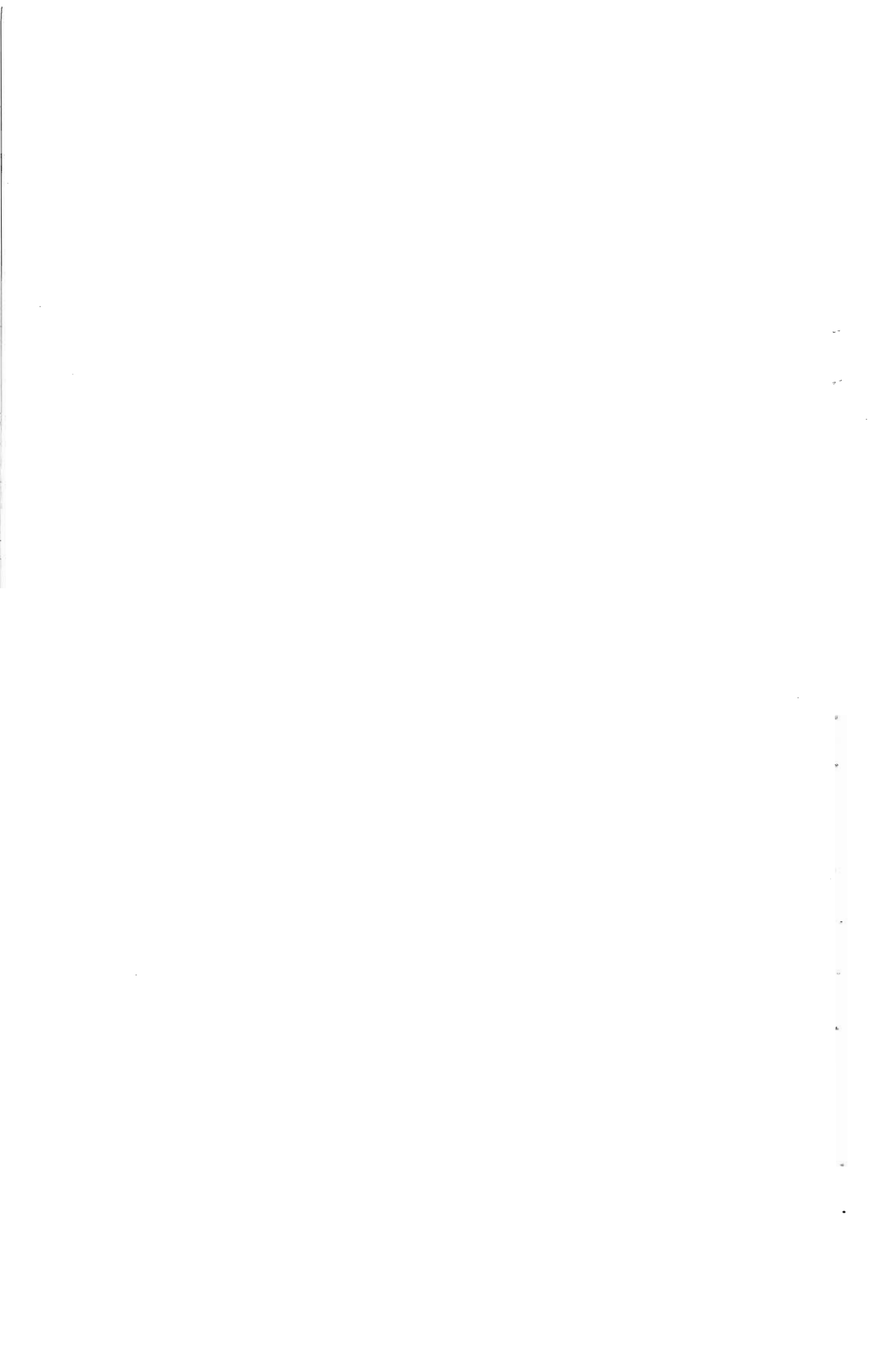


