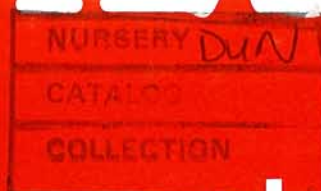

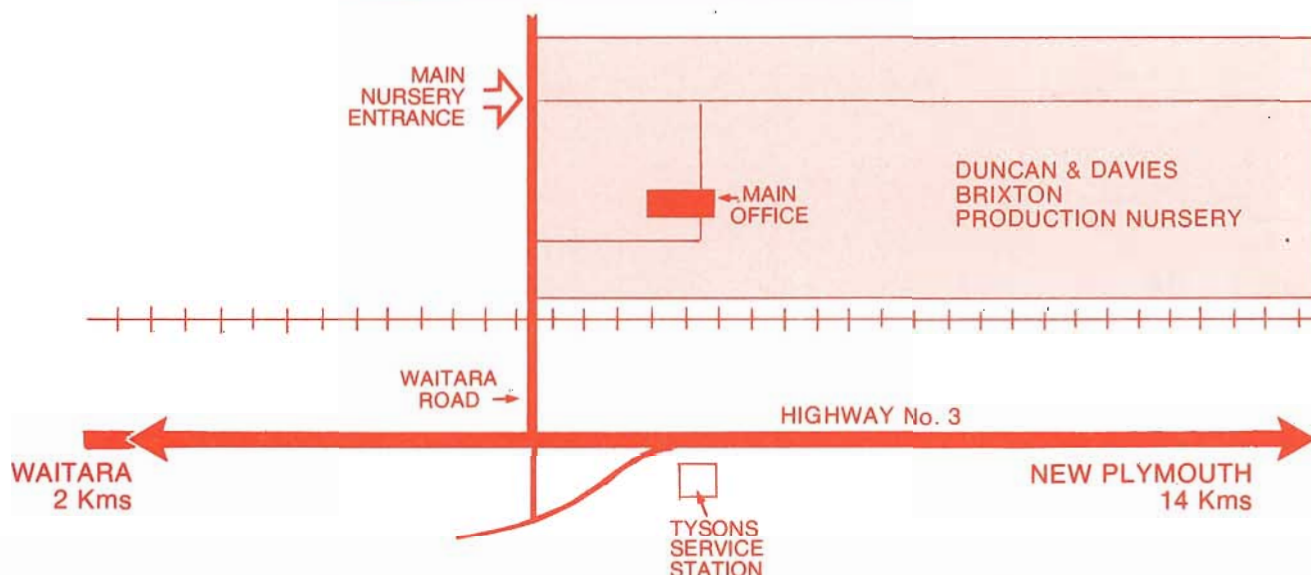



Camellias are really "**the plant of the moment**" in the U.K. and you may be interested to know that this year we have shipped in nearly 120,000 Camellias to our new nursery near Chichester, West Sussex. Despite the distance between New Zealand and England, we can still compete in their market because of our superior growth rates and range of varieties. The Camellia in England is regarded as a dual-purpose indoor/outdoor plant with many people buying them as indoor plants for Christmas gifts which can later be planted outside in the spring.

Incidentally, any of you planning to visit the U.K. to spend some of the vast profits you make selling D & D plants, are most welcome to visit the nursery which is less than 2 hours drive from London. Please, however, drop us a line first so that we can warn our U.K. colleagues to roll out the red carpet!
