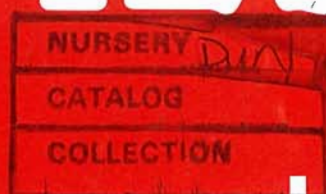

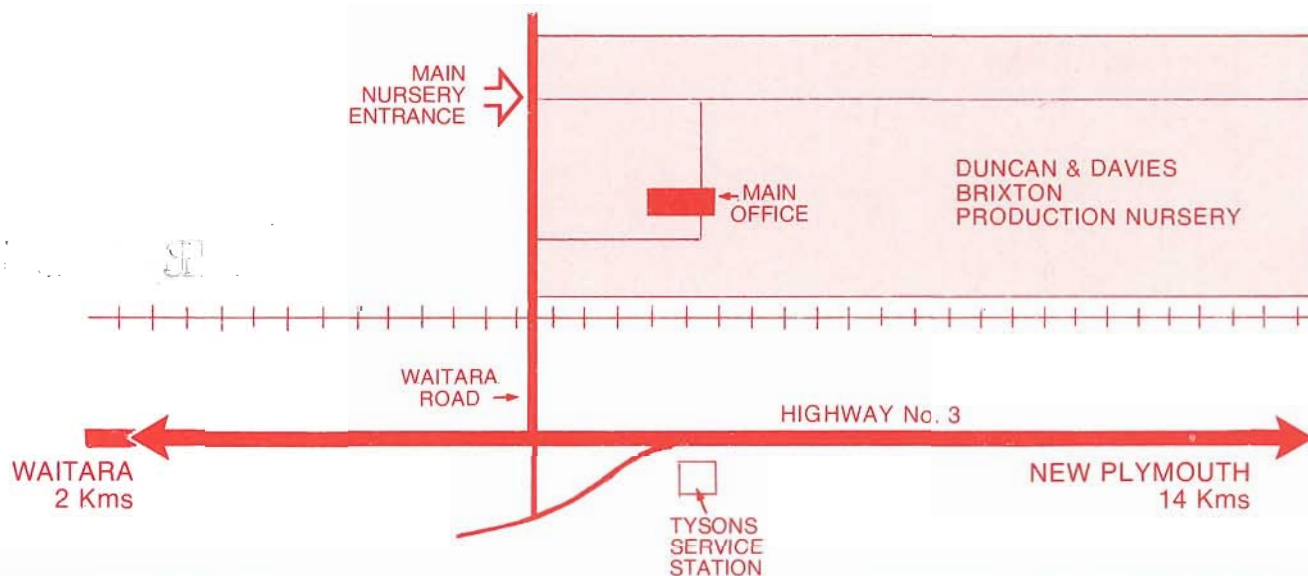

Originating from FORMOSA the following hybrid cultivars have been raised in the U.S.A. The major attraction of this new hybrid strain lies in its use as an evergreen ground covering plant; tub plant and as a unique hanging basket specimen.

The general habit is that of a low-growing, creeping shrub that moulds as it travels. Flowers late season after most other Azaleas have finished, giving a valuable extension to the season. Foliage in all cases is a glossy deep green that varies a little in tone between the various cultivars. Flowers are funnel-like bell shaped, produced in small clusters in various colour tones through clear pink, rose red to scarlet and dark brick red.

SOPHORA microphylla 'EARLYGOLD'

A newly developed dwarf Kowhai that is very slow in growth and compact in habit eventually making a small, neat shrub, pyramidal in shape, that could reach, in time, from one to two metres in height.

Foliage is small, finely textured and a glossy deep green in summer and semi deciduous to fully deciduous in winter dependent upon climatic conditions.

An abundance of elegant lemon yellow flowers are produced in pendulous clusters from late winter through into spring. Grows easily in most garden soils, but does prefer an open sunny situation for optimum growth and flowering.

An excellent hardy, small growing shrub ideal for the home garden with the added ability of succeeding well in coastal areas.

SOPHORA microphylla 'GOLDIES MANTLE'

A selected new weeping form of Kowhai with graceful pendulous branches sweeping down with long drooping leaves of soft texture and deepest green in summer and semi deciduous to fully deciduous in winter dependent upon climatic conditions.

'Goldies Mantle' makes a small weeping garden tree, which is expected, in time, to reach up to three metres in height.

It is recommended to stake and securely tie the main stem at planting time to maintain a strong upright leader and to achieve the anticipated height.

Bright golden flowers in long pendulous clusters are produced during late spring.

Grows easily in most garden soils but does prefer an open sunny situation for optimum growth and flowering. A graceful and elegant small growing garden tree.

SOPHORA microphylla 'GOLDILOCKS'

A newly developed Kowhai selected for its early flowering abilities and great abundance of flowers produced over a long flowering season.

A small upright growing tree with an open irregular vase shape, which will eventually make a dainty garden tree with an anticipated ultimate height of some three to four metres.

The foliage is small and fine in texture of rich green in summer and semi deciduous to fully deciduous in winter dependent upon climatic conditions.

Bark is an attractive silvery grey in maturity and makes a lovely colour combination when combined in spring with the dark brown velvety flower spurs and the rich golden yellow flowers so abundantly produced.

Grows easily in most garden soils, but does prefer an open sunny situation for optimum growth and flowering. An excellent hardy small growing tree ideal for the home garden.

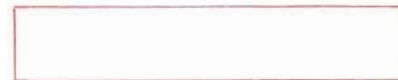
