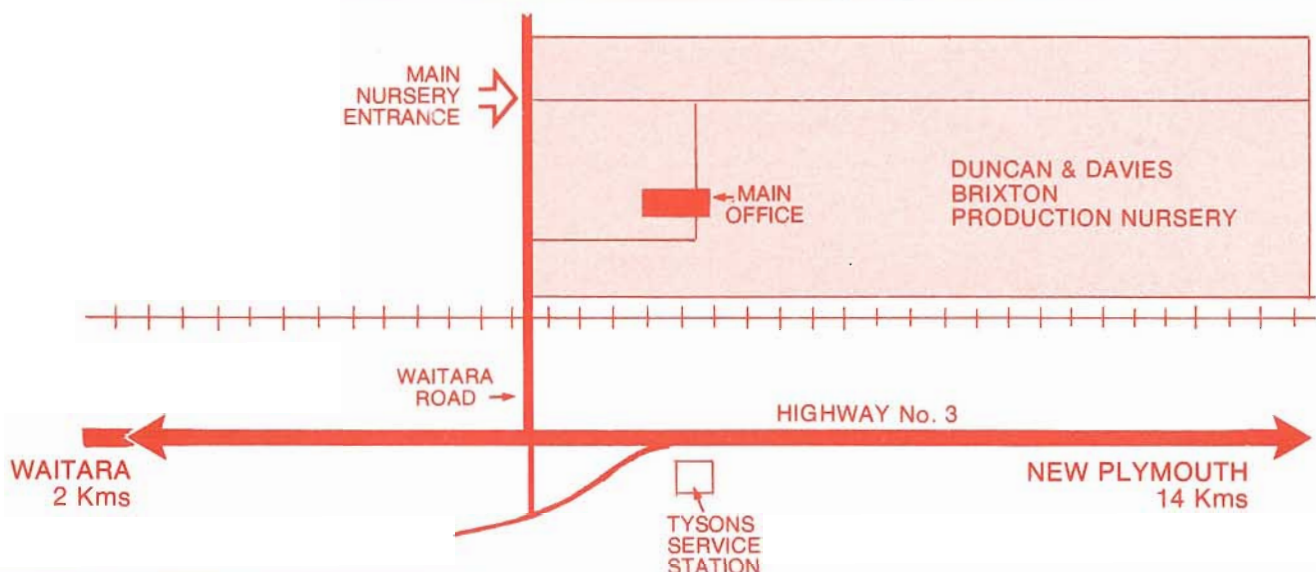

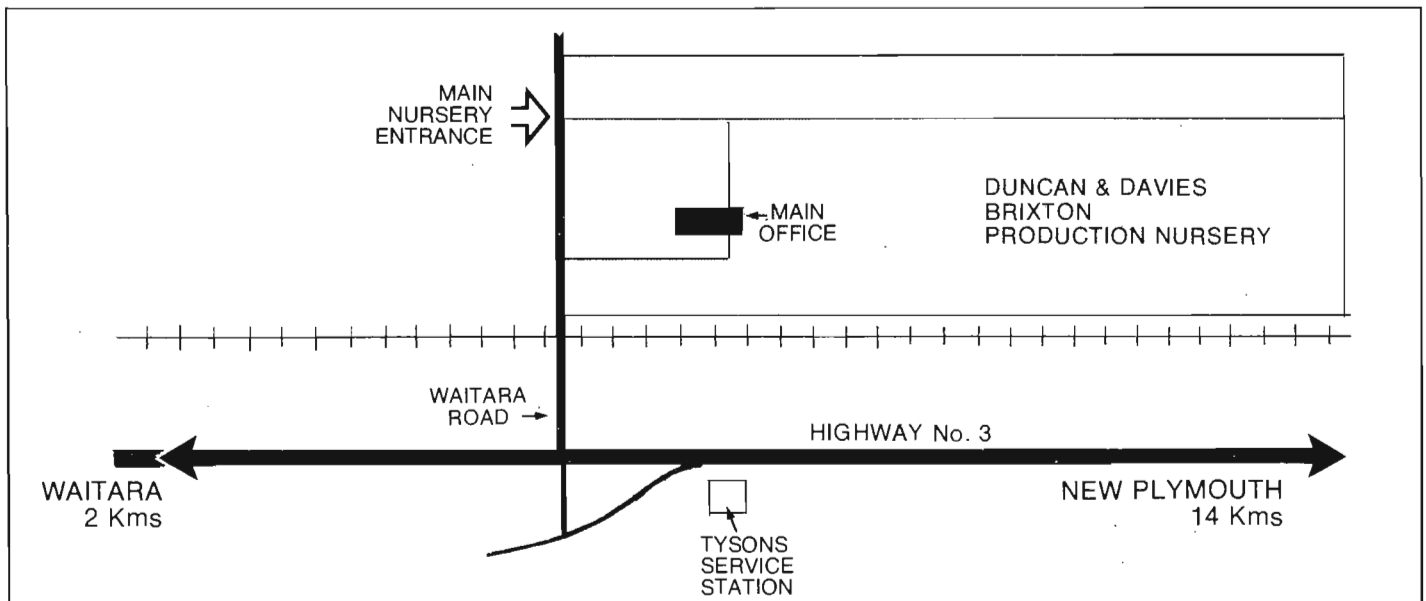

## EXPLANATION OF ABBREVIATIONS

'E' = Evergreen

'D' = Deciduous

**HEIGHTS** are approximate only but are a guide to what we consider the average height would be under normal garden conditions in 10 years.

**GRADES** indicated are the average standard grade we consider should be attained. At time of delivery grades may be larger or smaller but not below an acceptable minimum D & D grade.

**ROOT PROCESSING** - product will be processed according to the plants' requirements.

Throughout the list, the processing method has been indicated in abbreviated form. The key to the abbreviation is :

- NB - Net balled with a fully absorbent liner.
- SW - Sleeve Wrapped [deciduous product only].
- DS - Bagged into a Duncan & Davies draw string bag.
- PB - Bagged into a standard planter bag.
- RP - Rigid Pot.
- BR - Bare Root.
