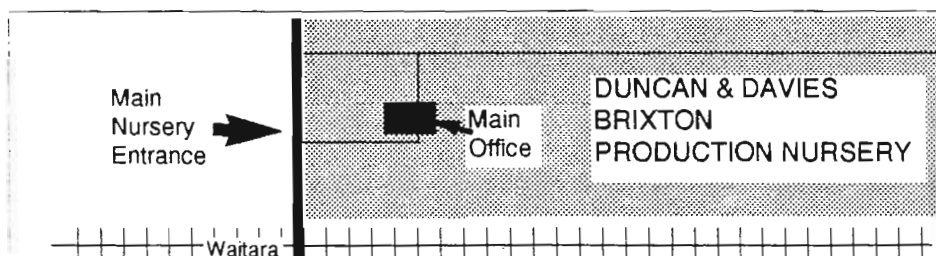

- 1: **DEFINITION:** "The Company" means DUNCAN & DAVIES NURSERIES LIMITED a duly incorporated company having its registered office at New Plymouth.
- 2: **SCOPE:** These terms and conditions apply to all sales of goods by the Company and shall prevail over any inconsistent terms or conditions contained or referred to in the customer's order or in correspondence or elsewhere unless specifically agreed to in writing by the Company.
- 3: **QUOTATIONS:** A quotation by the Company does not constitute an offer and the Company reserves the right to withdraw or amend the same at any time prior to the Company's acceptance of the customer's order.
- 4: **WHOLESALE ORDERS:** All sales are "subject to crop availability" and order accepted "subject unsold".
- 5: **WHOLESALE QUANTITIES:** Minimum order to the Company is 50 plants with a minimum of five plants of one variety. The Company regrets that orders of less than the above will not be accepted as these are uneconomical.
- 6: **PRICES AND GST:**
  - a) The prices payable for goods will be those quoted in the trade catalogue but the Company reserves the right to make a surcharge if unforeseen cost increases make this necessary. Prices quoted are GST exclusive and GST will be itemised as a separate figure on the invoice.
  - b) All prices include identification labels only and packaging.
  - c) All prices are ex Brixton Nursery.
  - d) All freight costs are for customer's account - see Clause 11.
- 7: **TERMS OF PAYMENT:**
  - a) All customers are required to pay cash at the time of the confirmation of their order unless the Company has agreed in writing to accept payment as set out in (b) hereof.
  - b) Payment is due on the 20th of the month following delivery. Interest shall be payable on overdue accounts at the rate of 2% per month to run from the due date for payment thereof until receipt by the Company of the full amount payable.
  - c) The Company shall have the right to withhold or suspend or to terminate any contract if a customer's account is not on a current basis.
- 8: **CANCELLATIONS:**
  - a) No cancellation of any order by the customer in whole or in part or deferment of delivery will be accepted unless agreed to in writing by the Company.
  - b) Whilst every endeavour is made by the Company to keep all nursery stock true to name and free from pests, virus and other diseases, if before delivery the goods are damaged or found to be diseased the Company may cancel the contract and on refunding any monies paid by the customer to the Company the Company shall not be under any further liability whatsoever to the customer.
- 9: **COMPLAINTS:**

The goods must be carefully examined on receipt. The Company will not be liable to the customer.

  - a) For shortages of quantities delivered unless the customer notifies the Company of any claim for short delivery in writing within five days of receipt of the goods.
  - b) For any loss or damage caused by the act, neglect or default of the customer or of any third party.
- 10: **OWNERSHIP:**
  - a) Ownership in the goods supplied shall remain with the Company until the goods are paid for.
  - b) The customer shall keep all goods supplied to it by the Company identified until such time as they have been paid for.
  - c) If the goods are sold to third parties prior to being paid for then the customer shall hold the proceeds of the sale in trust for the Company until the goods have been paid for. The buyer will on the demand of the Company provide full details of all sales made of goods that are not paid for and the accounts where the proceeds of the sales thereof are held.
  - d) The Company shall have the right to enter onto the customer's premises at any reasonable time to inspect or recover possession of any unsold goods not paid for in terms of Clause 7 hereof.
  - e) Notwithstanding the above the risk in any goods supplied by the Company to the customer shall pass when such goods leave the Company's Brixton premises. In the event of the Company recovering possession of any goods in accordance with the above provisions then the Company shall be entitled to be compensated by the customer for any damage to or loss of value of such goods.
- 11: **FREIGHT COSTS & INSURANCE:**
  - a) The customer shall be responsible for all freight costs from the Company's Brixton Nursery including demurrages, chaps when not promptly returned to the freight company following receipt of the goods.
  - b) All goods are despatched uninsured and at the buyer's risk. Claims for losses or damage in transit must be lodged promptly direct to the transport organisation concerned.
  - c) If the customer wishes to use its own transport to uplift plants from the Brixton Nursery, seven days notice is required to the Company, ten days notice during the winter season.
- 12: **TERMINATION:** If the customer commits any breach of these conditions or shall go into receivership or liquidation either, voluntarily or compulsory or shall enter into any composition with its creditors or shall suffer any distress or execution to be levied on its goods the Company may terminate any contract and refuse to effect further deliveries without any liability for damages.
- 13: **FORCE MAJEURE:**
  - a) In the event of war, hostilities or blockage preventing shipment or delivery during the contract period this contract or any unfilled part thereof shall be cancelled.
  - b) Should shipment or delivery be delayed by fire, strikes, lock outs, riots, revolution, prohibition of export or any executive or legislative act done by or on behalf of the Government of the territory where the place and/or places of shipment or delivery named therein is or are situated or for any other reason beyond the control of the Company other than the reasons given in Clause (a) at the time of shipment or delivery shall be extended by two months. Should shipment or delivery not be possible within these two months the contract shall be void unless otherwise agreed to in writing. If by reason of any cause beyond the control of the Company, the Company are unable to supply the full quantity to be supplied thereunder such failure shall not give rise to a claim against the Company or be deemed a breach of contract. The Company shall be at liberty to reduce deliveries hereunder to such an extent as may be necessary fairly to apportion between customers the quantity which the Company are at any time able to supply.
  - c) The Company shall advise customers without undue delay if shipment or delivery during the contract period is impossible with the reasons therefore. If required the Company must produce proof to justify their claim for cancellation or extension.
- 14: **WAIVER:** The failure on the part of the Company to exercise or enforce any rights conferred by the contract shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any such right nor operate so as to bar the exercise or enforcement thereof at any time or times thereafter.
- 15: **NOTICES:** Any notice required to be delivered hereunder shall be deemed to have been duly given if sent by post (airmail where the addressee is abroad), telex, bureaufax or telegraph addressed to the party concerned at its principal place of business or last known address.
- 16: **CREDIT FACILITIES:** Credit facilities may be extended to our customers by the Company on terms and conditions approved in writing by the General Manager or Company Secretary of the Company.
- 17: **GOVERNING LAW:** The contract shall be governed by and construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of New Zealand for the purpose of settlement of any dispute arising out of or in connection with the contract the parties hereto submit themselves
